

- Official credential evaluation is required for transfer students
- Deadline for Fall admission June 1st
- Deadline for Spring admission October 15th

- Transcripts from all universities attended
- 2 letters of recommendation
- TOEFL minimum iBT of 80, or IELTS 6.5, or PTE of 53, or level 112 from ELS Language Center (Engineering and Computer Science degrees require a 75 TOEFL or 6.0 IELTS, or a 50 PTE test score.)
- Resume, if any work experience
- Statement of purpose is not required, but encouraged
- GMAT or GRE scores, depending on the degree requirements
- Bank Statement and Affidavit of Support
- Deadline for Fall admission May 31st (This may vary according to degree sought.)
- Deadline for Spring admission October 31st

Undergraduate International Scholarships

 There are a number of scholarships available for undergraduate international students. Generally students who have a minimum 2.7 grade point average and meet our requirements for English proficiency (TOEFL-80, IELTS-6.5, or completion of ELS Level 112) will be considered for merit awards by the admissions committee.

Awards begin at \$10,000.


